57/21 Minutes

59/21 Matters arising from the minutes

60/21 Speed watch

No speed watch sessions have taken place due to the lockdown.

Sale of old speed gun - **Action** VM now has the speed gun and will attempt to sell the same so funds can be generated for a better replacement. **Action** CB will forward details of the recommended speed gun so estimates can be obtained.

61/21 Speeding on Twemlow Lane

Speeding continues.

Action – VM to request a further visit by the PSCO with the speed camera. It is suggested the PSCO should park at the oil works or Twemlow Manor Fields and position himself accordingly.

Speeding has also been noted onto and off Twemlow Manor Fields. It seems residents have erected their own safety signs. **Action** – VM to advise PCSO so this can be looked into.

RTA'S – A fatal accident was reported between a van and a cyclist at the Chelford Road/Bridge Road junction near Terra Nova school. TPC would like to send condolences to the family and friends of the cyclist. It is understood that the cyclist was involved in a time trial race at the time of the accident. **Action** – VM to contact AK to find out more information for the time trial permits.

The grid opposite number 9 Twemlow Lane is broken and needs repairing. **Action** – VM to report to Cheshire East.

There is a leak on the A%£% between Bank Farm and Twemlow Edge. **Action** – MB to speak to Patsy Barnett who has more information regarding this leak.
